CONDUCT OF EXPANSION 30-MINUTE READING AND NUMERACY-FOCUSED PERIOD (RNFP) FOR GRADE 2 LEARNERS PRE-TEST AND POST-TEST FOR QTR. 4 OF SY 2024-2025

TO: Assistant Schools Division Superintendent
Chief Education Supervisors
Division Education Program Supervisors/Coordinators/Specialists
Elementary and Secondary School Heads/OICs/TICs

- 1. The Schools Division of Escalante City through the Curriculum Implementation Division (CID) will conduct the Expansion 30-Minute Remediation and Numeracy-Focused Period (RNFP) for Grade 2 Learners Pre-test and Post-test for Qtr. 4 of SY 2024-2025 on February 26-27, 2025 and March 25-26, 2025, respectively.
- 2. The Grade 2 Teachers will be responsible for conducting the pre-test and post-test. Elementary School Heads will closely supervise and monitor the conduct of the tests and task the Grade 2 Teachers to encode the pre-test results in the drive provided by the SDO **on or before March 5, 2025** and the post-test results **on or before March 29, 2025**.
- 3. The Expansion 30-Minute Remediation and Numeracy Focused Period (RNFP) pre-test and post-test results shall be used to determine the percentage of improvement in the performance of learners in Qtr. 4 in each school. The progress of learners shall be tracked after the utilization of the available and initiated 30-Minute Remediation and Numeracy Focused Period Learning Activity Sheets developed by Grade 2 Teachers for Qtr. 4 to improve their numeracy skills as part of the SDO initiative.
- 4. The access link of the assessment materials which will be reproduced by the schools will be provided in the Group Chat.
- 5. External monitors from the CID shall monitor the schools' conduct of the activity.
- 6. Expenses relative to the conduct of the activity shall be charged against Local Funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
- 7. Immediate dissemination of and compliance with this Memorandum are desired.
