ADMINISTRATION OF REGIONAL ACHIEVEMENT MEASURE (RAM) FOR SY 2024-2025

- OIC-Assistant Schools Division Superintendent Chief Education Supervisors Public Elementary and Secondary School Heads and TICs All Others Concerned
- Relative to Regional Memorandum No. 825, s. 2023 titled Administration of the Regional Achievement Measure (RAM) for Grades 1 to 12 for School Years 2022-2023 to 2028-2029, this Office, through the Curriculum Implementation Division (CID) informs the field on the Administration of Regional Achievement Measure (RAM) for SY 2024-2025 on March 20-21 & March 25-26, 2025.
- The RAM aims to:
 - a. Evaluate the performance of learners across all grade levels and subject areas;
 - b. Provide baseline data for the Regional Education Development Plan (REDP), Division Education Development Plan (DEDP), and School Improvement Plan (SIP); and
 - c. Identify learning competency gaps to guide the development of targeted interventions, programs, projects, and activities to improve learning outcomes.
- The RAM will be administered in digital form, paper-and-pen test or combination of the two. There will be a maximum of 30 test takers per room for both digital and paper-and-pen tests.
- 4. See enclosure No. 1 for the suggested seat plan on the administration of RAM.
- The Curriculum Implementation Division (CID), the Schools Governance and Operations Division and selected OSDS personnel shall conduct Monitoring and Evaluation on the administration of RAM.
- See enclosure No. 2 for the Monitoring, Evaluation and Technical Assistance tool on the administration of RAM and enclosure No. 3 for the RAM Administration Guidelines.
- The schools can reproduce the RAM materials in 1:1 ratio when resources are available but are also allowed to practice austerity measures adopting the seat plan and schedule found in the enclosure.
- It is understood that in the conduct of this activity, there shall be no discrimination on account of age, gender, civil status, disability, religion, or other similar factors/personal circumstances that run counter to the principles of equal opportunity.
- Expenses relative to the conduct of the test will be charged against Local Funds/ MOOE Funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
