

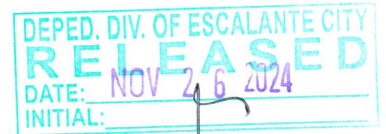

**DIVISION ORIENTATION ON CAMPUS JOURNALISM**

1. The Schools Division of Escalante City through the Curriculum and Teaching Division shall conduct **Division Orientation on Campus Journalism to School Paper Advisers both English and Filipino, Elementary and Secondary Level on December 7, 2024 (1 pm) at Escalante National High School.**
2. This activity aims to:
  - a. orient 100% (41 out of 41) of the school paper advisers in the Schools Division of Escalante City about Campus Journalism.
  - b. enhance the journalistic knowledge, skills, and ethical values of the school paper advisers.
  - c. recognize the role of journalism in advocating for social consciousness and environmental awareness.
3. The participants in this activity are the School Paper Advisers both English and Filipino, Elementary and Secondary Level.
4. Attached in Enclosure 1 are the activity matrix and the participants of the activity.
5. Expenses relative to the conduct of the activity shall be charged against Local Funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
6. It is understood that in the conduct of this activity, there shall be no discrimination on the account of age, school, gender, civil status, disability, religion, or any other similar factor/circumstances that are against to the principles of equal opportunity.
7. Participants shall be entitled to service credits in accordance with DepED Order No. 53, s. 2003 entitled "Updated Guidelines on the Grant of Vacation Service Credits to Teachers." However, non-teaching personnel including Training Management Staff shall be given Compensatory Time-Off (CTO) in accordance with Civil Service Commission (CSC) and Department of Budget and Management (DBM) Joint Circular No. 2, s. 2004, on Non-Monetary Remuneration for Overtime Service Rendered, with specific attention on Section 5.
