However, non-teaching personnel including Training Management Staff shall be given Compensatory Time-Off (CTO) in accordance with Civil Service Commission (CSC) and Department of Budget and Management (DBM) Joint Circular No. 2, s. 2004, on Non-Monetary Remuneration for Overtime Service Rendered, with specific attention on Section 5.
