- 1. Relative to the Regional Memorandum No. 838, s. 2024 titled *Regional Upskilling of English Teachers in Language Instruction* and anchored on the MATATAG Agenda of giving support to teachers to teach better, SDO Escalante City shall conduct the Division Upskilling of English Teachers and School Heads in Language Instruction on **December 9-10,2024** at AGR Hall, SUNN Hotel, Sagay City, Negros Occidental.
