

CONDUCT OF DIVISION POSTER MAKING, ESSAY WRITING, AND ORATORICAL CONTEST IN LINE WITH THE 83rd COMMEMORATION OF THE ARAW NG KAGITINGAN AND 2025 PHILIPPINE VETERANS' WEEK

- 1. Pursuant to RM No. 230, s.2025, titled "Conduct of National Poster Making, Essay Writing, and Oratorical Contest in Line with the 83rd Commemoration of the Araw ng Kagitingan and 2025 Philippine Veterans' Week", the celebration will be on April 5 to 11, 2025 highlighting the commemoration of the heroism of Filipino and American soldiers during the fall of Bataan in 1942 as well as paying tribute to all veterans who served the nation and fought bravely during World War II. With this, the Schools Division of Escalante City through the Curriculum Implementation Division (CID) will conduct the Poster Making contest on March 18, 2025 and the Essay Writing and Oratorical Contest on March 20, 2025, 2:00 p.m. at Escalante National High School.
- 2. The said contests aim to:
 - a. honor and commemorate the heroism and sacrifices of Filipino and American soldiers during the fall of Bataan in 1942;
 - enhance learners' critical thinking, creativity, and communication skills through poster making, essay writing, and oratorical competitions that promote awareness of the significance of Araw ng Kagitingan and the contributions of war veterans;
 - c. provide students with a platform to express their gratitude and respect for Filipino veterans by showcasing their artistic talents, writing skills, and public speaking abilities in a meaningful and historically significant event;
 - d. instill in the youth a deeper appreciation for the values of courage, resilience, and nationalism by encouraging them to reflect on historical events; and
 - e. identify excelling learners in the contests to represent the SDO to Regional level competition.
- 3. Participants in the contests are learner-contestants, coaches, judges, facilitators, TWGs, Education Program Supervisor in Araling Panlipunan, and members of the Execom.
- 4. Enclosed is the list of judges and TWGs, RM No. 230, s. 2025 and Memorandum DM-OUOPS-2025 for reference.
- 5. Participation in the activity is voluntary and shall not, in any way, affect the time-on-task of teachers as this activity's target learning standards and competencies are already embedded in teachers' actual classroom teaching and assessment process.

NATIONAL POSTER MAKING CONTEST

1. Background and Objectives

In celebration of the 83rd Araw ng Kagitingan and Philippine Veterans Week, the Department of Education (DepEd), and the Veterans Federation of the Philippines (VFP) are sponsoring a National Poster-Making Contest.

These contest aim to showcase the historical sites across the country from the Second World War II era, where significant landmarks and memorials now stand. This initiative seeks to cultivate a sense of pride and reverence among Filipinos for the sacrifices made by our veterans, serving as a poignant reminder of the valuable legacy that has granted us the freedom we cherish today.

2. Participants

The contest is open to all Grades 11 & 12, learners enrolled in any public and private secondary schools nationwide. Private school should be duly recognized by DepEd. Previous winners of all DepEd-Special Events Unit- organized contests are ineligible to join to give others a chance.

3. Scope/Theme

The entries should depict the life, works, and heroism of our Filipino heroes who fought for our country and should be in line with this year's theme, "KABAYANIHAN NG BETERANO: SANDIGAN NG KAUNLARAN AT KASAGANAAN NG BAGONG PILIPINAS"

4. Entry Specification

Only submitted entries that satisfy the requirements and specifications of the contest will be considered official.

- The poster should be on a 15"x 20" illustration board.
- 4.2 Contestants may use any medium of his/her choice, (e.g. oil paste, crayon, and watercolor)
- 4.3 The poster must be described in one or two sentences. The description must be typewritten and printed on a 1/2 A4 bond paper and posted at the back of the entry together with the following information:
 - 4.3.1 Name of Learner 4.3.2 Contact Number

 - 4.3.3 School
 - 4.3.4 Division
 - 4.3.5 Region
- The Philippine Flag should not be used as the background of the poster. If used as part, it should be placed in a conspicuous place to show its importance to the artwork (please refer to Sec. 39 -Prohibited Acts under Republic Act (RA) No. 8491 titled "An Act

83RD ARAW NG KAGITINGAN AND PHILIPPINE VETERANS WEEK CONTEST MECHANICS AND GUIDELINES

NATIONAL ORATORICAL CONTEST

Subject to such changes as may be determined appropriate, the following general rules shall apply:

1. Participants

The contest is open to all Grades 9, 10, 11 and 12 learners enrolled in any public and private elementary schools nationwide. Private school should be duly recognized by DepEd. Previous winners of all DepEd-Special Events Unitorganized contests are ineligible to join to give others a chance.

2. Theme and Content

The oratorical piece must be in Filipino, original, never been published, and expounding on the theme: "KABAYANIHAN NG BETERANO: SANDIGAN NG KAUNLARAN AT KASAGANAAN NG BAGONG PILIPINAS".

The piece must be delivered for a minimum of five (5) minutes and a maximum of seven (7) minutes.

The oration MUST NOT, in whole or in part, whether express or implied, offend any race or religious freedom, nor should it be against the environmental laws, honor, dignity, or the moral standards of Filipinos.

3. Criteria

3.1.Content	50%
Sincerity, originality and relevance to the theme	
3.2.Delivery	40%
Posture, gesture, eye contact, facial expressio	
pronunciation, volume and mastery	
3.3. Persuasion and Stage Presence	10%
TOTAL	100%

4. Regional Qualifier

Each Region should have one contestant in the Oratorical Contest to represent the region in the National Level. Regions may conduct a Regional Level Competition or select a regional representative to compete in the National Level.

5. Attire

During the final competition, the contestants shall wear the appropriate attire

- 4.6. have a minimum of three (3) pages and a maximum of four (4) pages.
