# PARTICIPATION TO THE 2-DAY MANLAMBUS DANCE WORKSHOP

- 1. In collaboration with the Escalante City Tourism Office, and in anticipation of the upcoming 2025 Manlambus Festival Street Dancing, the Department of Education (DepEd) of Escalante City will be sending participants to a two-day Manlambus Dance Workshop. This workshop is scheduled for April 10-11, 2025, and will take place at the Social Hall, located within the New Government Center (also known as the Pentagon).
- 2. The purpose of the workshop is to provide participants with the necessary training and preparation for the street dancing event, which is a key highlight of the Manlambus Festival.
- 3. Participants to this activity are the selected MAPEH teachers, Master Teachers, and School Heads. See attached list of participants.
- 4. The DO 13, s. 2024 titled Revised Guidelines on the Grant of Vacation Service Credits. The Division Education Program Supervisors (DEPS) and Teacher-Coaches involved in this activity shall be provided with Compensatory Time Off (CTO) for the service rendered during weekends and holidays as per Civil Service Commission (CSC) and Department of Budget & Management (DBM Joint Circular No. 2, s. 2004) on Non-Monetary Remuneration for Overtime Service rendered will be availed by the participants.
- 5. Expenses relative to this activity shall be chargeable against local funds/SEF/School MOOE or any other available funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and procedures.
- 6. Participation and joining the activity shall be subject to the non-disruption of classes policy stipulated in DepEd Order # 009, s. 2005 titled "Instituting Measure to Increase Engaged Time-on-Task and Ensuring Compliance Therewith"
- 7. It is understood that in the conduct of the activity, there shall be no discrimination on account of age, school, gender, civil status, disability, religion, or other similar factors/personal circumstances that run counter to the principles of equal opportunity.
