- The participants shall bring laptop, wireless wifi router, extension cord and two certified true copies of the following:
 - a.) TESDA National Certificate (NC)
 - b.) Live Birth or Marriage Contract;
 - c.) Letter of Intent and
 - d.) Memorandum of Agreement









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- 5. The board and lodging, training expenses, per diem, and travel expenses of the participants shall be charged against Sub-Allotment Released Order No. OSEC-6-24-5216 and local funds to augment the insufficiency of the downloaded funds, subject to the usual government accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
- 6. The teacher participants shall be entitled to service credit during Saturday, Sunday and Holiday in accordance with DepEd Order No. 53, s. 2023 titled *Updated Guidelines on the Grant of Vacation Service Credits to Teachers*. Likewise, non-teaching personnel including the Regional Management Team may avail of the Compensatory Time Off (CTO) for their services during weekend and holidays as per Civil Service Commission (CSC) and Department of Budget and Management (DBM) Joint Circular No. 2 s. 2024 titled *Non-Monetary Renumeration for Overtime Service Rendered* on account of their direct involvement in the training.
- 7. It is understood that in the conduct of this activity, there shall be no discrimination on account of age, school, gender, civil status, disability, religion or other similar factors/personal circumstances that runs counter to the principle of equitable opportunity.
