- 1. The Department of Education remains steadfast in its commitment to delivering quality, accessible, relevant, and liberating basic education for all Filipino learners. One of the department's top priorities is to improve numeracy outcomes and reduce learning poverty, particularly in foundational learning areas such as Mathematics.
