

RELEASE OF CLAIMS FOR MONETIZATION OF LEAVE CREDITS

- 1. This Office, thru the Budget Section, is pleased to announce the release of funds by the Department of Budget and Management (DBM) for the monetization of leave credits for identified personnel of this office.
- 2. The release of funds for approved monetization is based on Section 23 of Civil Service Commission Memorandum Circular No. 41, s. 1998, dated December 24, 1998 (Subject: Amendments to Rules I and XVI of the Omnibus Rules Implementing Book V of the Administrative Code of 1987) which expressly provides that "Monetization of fifty percent (50%) of all the accumulated leave credits may be allowed for valid and justifiable reasons subject to the discretion of the agency head and the availability of funds."
- 3. Personnel who were deemed not qualified as of this date may re-submit their application at the end of the year, subject to the approval and availability of funds.
- Release of said claims will commence in June 2025.
