  - c. cultivate professionalism, collaboration, and creativity, upholding quality, consistency, and accountability in support of DepEd-Escalante Division mandate to deliver learner-centered educational materials responsive to diverse student needs.

4. The participants are required to bring laptop with extension cord and pen tablets.
5.
