**DIVISION JOURNALISM CLINIQUING FOR THE QUALIFIERS OF THE 2026 REGIONAL SCHOOLS PRESS CONFERENCE (RSPC)**

1. Pursuant to Republic Act 7079 also known as the *Campus Journalism Act of 1991*, SDO Escalante City Curriculum Implementation Division (CID) will conduct the Division Journalism Cliniquing for the Qualifiers of the 2026 Regional Schools Press Conference (RSPC) on February 16, 2026 at ECES.
2. The activity aims to ;
  - a. enhance the campus journalistic knowledge, skills and ethical values of the participants;
  - b. strengthen their capability on the various fields of journalism for positive changes in the coaching of the school paper advisers and campus writers' articles; and
  - c. appreciate the importance of responsible journalism in its advocacy for empowering communities
3. The participants in this activity are the top three Elementary and Secondary DSPC winners with their advisers both English and Filipino.
4. It is understood that in the conduct of this activity, there shall be no discrimination on the account of age, school gender, civil status, disability, religion or other similar circumstances that run counter to the principle of equal opportunities.

6. The facilitators will join the walkthrough of the cliniquing materials on February 13, 2026, 8:00 a.m. at the CID office.
7. The participation to this activity is subject to the "No disruption of classes policy" as stipulated in Deped Order No. 9, s. 2005 entitled "Instituting Measures to increase Engaged Time on Task and Ensuring Compliance Therewith". The school should take necessary measures to ensure that the teaching load of teacher-participants will be taken care-of and No classes will be missed by the learners.



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8. A registration fee of P1,000.00 shall be collected to cover necessary expenses for the activity, auto-deducted from non-implementing units and collected from implementing units (IUs) via cash or check/LDDAP, chargeable against local funds/MOOE and subject to usual accounting and auditing rules.
