

1. The Schools Division of Escalante City informs the field that there will be a **Conference-Workshop on Cha-Ching Curriculum** for all **elementary Financial Literacy Focals** to be conducted on **March 6, 2026 at E-Classroom Escalante Central Elementary School, Escalante City.**
2. Specifically, the activity aims to:
  - a. revisit the key concepts, framework, and integration- teaching strategies of the Cha-Ching Curriculum;
  - b. strengthen the utilization of the Cha-Ching instructional materials and resources in classroom implementation;
  - c. develop a school-level implementation plan for the systematic integration of the Cha-Ching Curriculum across relevant learning areas.
  - d. align school-based financial literacy initiatives with the DepEd goals and priorities; and
3. All Elementary School Heads are directed to ensure the attendance of their designated Financial Literacy Focal Person.

5. All participants are advised to bring a laptop, extension cord, internet modem, and a copy of their previous Cha-Ching Curriculum integration implementation plan to facilitate the workshop on crafting and refining their respective school implementation plans for the current year.

This activity adheres to DepEd Order No. 9, s. 2005 titled "*Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time-on-Task and Ensuring Compliance Therewith.*" In this regard, School Heads are reminded to ensure that teacher-participants' classes are properly managed and that learning resources are adequately provided to learners in strict observance of the "No Disruption of Classes Policy."
