- a. Instructional Supervision, Classroom Observations and findings;
- b. Conduct of EoSY Assessments and Submission of Results (CRLA, Phil-IRI, Rapid Mathematics Assessment (RMA), ECD Checklist, others);
- c. Timelines in the conduct of the 4th Quarterly Assessment (Submission of teacher-made test based on the Table of Specifications (TOS));
- d. 3rd Quarterly Assessment Least Learned Competencies and presentation of sample lesson plan;
- e. Remaining activities for the SY 2025-2026 in the Learning Area/LR; and
- f. Other Learning Area Concerns/LR Concerns.

The CID-SSACI shall be conducted by the Division Education Program Supervisors (DEPS)/Coordinator in the learning area and participated by the School Subject Area Coordinators of the forty-two (42) schools of this Division. **Likewise, the School Heads are also encouraged to attend the CID- SSACI.** The minutes of the meeting shall be submitted on **March 13, 2026.**
