1. In reference to **Regional Memorandum No. 321, s. 2026** titled “*Conduct of Training for Regional Trainers on the Revised Grades 6, 9, and 10 Curriculum,*” this Office informs the field that the Schools Division of Escalante City shall participate in the Training of Trainers (TOT) to be conducted by the Department of Education Central Office through the National Educators Academy of the Philippines (NEAP) on **April 20–24, 2026 for Grade 6**, and **April 27 to May 1, 2026 for Grades 9 and 10** within the National Capital Region.
2. This activity aims to equip selected teachers, Education Program Supervisors (EPS), and School Heads with a comprehensive understanding of the key features, standards, and learning competencies of the revised curriculum, including enhancements in content, pedagogy, and assessment practices. It also seeks to strengthen their competencies in instructional planning, curriculum alignment, and effective delivery of learning, thereby ensuring the Division’s readiness for implementation.
3. The selected participants shall form part of the pool of Regional Trainers for the roll-out of the Revised Grades 6, 9, and 10 Curriculum. They shall likewise serve as resource persons and facilitators during the regional and subsequent division-level roll-outs and shall provide technical assistance to schools to ensure quality, consistency, and fidelity in curriculum implementation. As such, they are expected to actively participate in all sessions and demonstrate mastery of the curriculum content and delivery strategies.
4. Attached to this Memorandum is the official list of participants to the training for guidance and reference.
5. The participants are reminded to bring their own laptops, chargers, extension cords, other sources of internet connectivity, and personal wellness and health kit (as needed).
