Pursuant to Republic Act (RA) No. 12028, otherwise known as the Academic Recovery and Accessible Learning (ARAL) Program Act of 2024 with the Department of Education's commitment to strengthen literacy and numeracy to ensure quality foundational learning, this Division Office, through the Curriculum Implementation Division (CID), will conduct an Orientation of the Guidelines on the Implementation of the 2026 Summer Remediation Programs **on April 30, 2026 at 1:00 p.m. at Gabriela Hall.**

The participants in this activity are the School Heads, Education Program Supervisors (EPSs), SGOD personnel (specifically the Monitoring and Evaluation Program Specialist II, Human Resource Training and Development EPS II and Planning Officer), Division IT Officer, and Administrative Officer IV-HR.
