The purpose of using the balances of the PSFs and/or directly released funds is for the efficient utilization of public funds to ensure that the DepEd's programs and projects deliver maximum benefits to their intended stakeholders.
- Funds to cover Snacks (AM & PM) and Lunch will be downloaded to each school through Cash Advances and will be liquidated thereafter by submitting the necessary documents: School Memorandum, Signed Payroll, Attendance Sheets and pictures.


