**ADDENDUM TO DIVISION MEMORANDUM NO. 201, S. 2026 -
DIVISION TRAINING OF TEACHERS ON THE REVISED
GRADES 6, 9, AND 10 CURRICULUM**

1. Relative to **Division Memorandum No. 201, s. 2026** titled, “**Division Training of Teachers on the Revised Grades 6, 9, and 10 Curriculum,**” this **Addendum** is issued to provide **additional guidelines on the grant of Vacation Service Credits (VSC) and Compensatory Time-Off (CTO)** to qualified personnel participating in the said activity.
2. Teaching personnel who are officially designated as participants, facilitators, resource persons, class managers, secretariat members, and members of the Technical Working Group and who render actual service during the conduct of the training on **May 27, 28, and 29, 2026, and June 2 to 6, 2026 shall be entitled to the corresponding Vacation Service Credits (VSC)**, subject to existing DepEd policies, submission of complete attendance records, and approval of the Schools Division Superintendent.
3. Non-teaching personnel who are officially designated and who render actual service in connection with the conduct of the activity on **May 27, 2026 (Eid’l Adha Regular Holiday) and June 6, 2026 (Saturday) shall be entitled to the corresponding Compensatory Time-Off (CTO)**, subject to existing Civil Service Commission rules and regulations, submission of the required supporting documents, and approval of the proper authority.
4. Services rendered by non-teaching personnel on May 28, 29, and June 2 to 5, 2026 shall be considered part of their regular official duties and shall not be covered by the grant of Compensatory Time-Off unless otherwise authorized under existing rules and regulations.
5. All other provisions of Division Memorandum No. 201, s. 2026 which are not affected by this Addendum shall remain in full force and effect.
6. Immediate dissemination of and compliance with this Memorandum are desired.
