**PARTICIPATION IN THE 2026 WORLD BLOOD DONOR DAY
BLOODLETTING ACTIVITY**

TO: OIC - Assistant Schools Division Superintendent
Chief Education Supervisors
Education Program Supervisors/ Specialists
Public Elementary and Secondary School Heads/TIC's
All Others Concerned

1. In celebration of World Blood Donor Day with the theme, "One Drop of Humanity. Give Blood. Save Lives.", all qualified teaching and non-teaching personnel are hereby encouraged to participate in the Blood Donation Activity organized by the Escalante City Primary Care Facility on June 25, 2026 at the Escalante Coliseum 8:00 am.
2. The activity aims to promote voluntary blood donation, strengthen community blood reserves, and help ensure the availability of safe blood for patients in need during emergencies, medical procedures, and other life-saving interventions.
3. Participation in the activity shall be on a voluntary basis and subject to the eligibility requirements set by the organizers and attending medical personnel.
4. Personnel interested in donating blood are advised to observe the following guidelines:
 - a. Get at least 6–8 hours of sleep the night before donation;
 - b. Eat a healthy meal prior to donating blood;
 - c. Drink plenty of water and do not consume alcoholic beverages within twenty-four (24) hours prior to donation;
 - d. Bring a valid identification card;
 - e. Inform the medical screening team of any medications being taken and relevant medical conditions;
 - f. Do not donate if experiencing fever, infection, flu-like symptoms, or other illnesses;
 - g. Wear comfortable clothing with sleeves that can be easily rolled up; and
 - h. Follow all instructions provided by the blood donation team before, during, and after the procedure.
5. School Heads are requested to disseminate this Memorandum to all teaching and non-teaching personnel and facilitate participation of interested and qualified employees without disruption of school operations and delivery of essential services.
6. Immediate dissemination of and compliance with this Memorandum are desired.
