All School PEACE Focal Persons are hereby directed to submit both soft and hard copies of their **Quarter 1 and Quarter 2 School Compliance Reports**, using the prescribed template in Enclosure 1, **on or before July 1, 2026**. Soft copies shall be uploaded through the following Google Drive link: <https://tinyurl.com/PEACEQ1Q2ComplianceReports>. The Enclosure 1 template is already provided in the said Google Drive folder for reference and use.
6. It is understood that in the conduct of this activity, there shall be no discrimination in the provision of such partnership on account of age, school, gender, civil status, disability, religion or other similar factors, personal circumstances that run counter to the principles of equal opportunity.

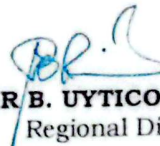
