**UTILIZATION OF THE ESCALANTE CITY CULTURAL INVENTORY IN THE
DEVELOPMENT OF CONTEXTUALIZED LEARNING RESOURCES**

1. Pursuant to the provisions of Republic Act No. 10533, which mandates the localization and contextualization of the basic education curriculum, and DepEd Order No. 021, s. 2019, which reinforces the implementation of contextualized and culture-responsive instruction, the Schools Division of Escalante City, through the Curriculum Implementation Division (CID), shall conduct the **Utilization of the Escalante City Cultural Inventory in the Development of Contextualized Learning Resources** on **July 11, 2026, 8:00 a.m.** at **Escalante City Elementary School Computer Laboratory**.
2. The activity aims to deepen understanding and enhance skills of the Araling Panlipunan teachers in utilizing the Escalante City Cultural Inventory as a primary reference in developing contextualized and localized learning resources aligned with the learning competencies.
3. Specifically, the activity seeks to:
 - a. deepen participants' understanding of the contents and educational significance of the Escalante City Cultural Inventory;
 - b. demonstrate strategies for integrating local historical, cultural, and heritage resources into classroom instruction; and
 - c. develop contextualized learning resources that reflect the cultural identity and heritage of Escalante City.
4. The participants to this activity are the members of Execom, Education Program Supervisor in Araling Panlipunan, Araling Panlipunan Coordinators, and Program Management Team.
5. Araling Panlipunan Coordinators are requested to bring their laptop, extension cords, existing contextualized learning resources for the workshop.
6. Attached are the matrix of activities and the list of participants. **(See Encls. 1 and 2)**
7. The teacher involved in the activity are entitled to Service Credits for his services during the cliniquing sessions and during the conduct of the activity but not to exceed 15 days in accordance with DepEd Order No. 53, s. 2003 titled "Updated Guidelines on the Grant of Vacation Service Credits to Teachers." On the other hand, non-teaching personnel shall be provided with Compensatory Time Off (CTO) for their services rendered during the weekend per Civil Service Commission (CSC) and Department of Budget and Management (DBM) Joint Circular No. 2, s. 2004 on Non-Monetary Remuneration for Overtime Service Rendered.



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8. It is understood that in the conduct of this activity, there shall be no discrimination on account of age, school, gender, civil status, disability, religion or other similar factors/ personal circumstances that run counter to the principles of equal opportunity.
9. Travel and other incidental expenses incurred by the participants shall be charged against local funds or other available funds, subject to the usual accounting, budgeting, and auditing rules and regulations.
