Following a productive coordination meeting with the Private Sector Jobs Skills Corporation (PCORP), this Office provides a list of PCORP's industry partners in select regions that shall serve as the basis for Schools Division Offices (SDOs) and senior high schools to conduct a strategic "School-Company Matching" specifically for School Year (SY) 2026-2027.

These efforts are aimed at strengthening and leveraging the implementation of the Work Immersion for Senior High School (SHS) Technical-Vocational-Livelihood (TVL)/Technical-Professional (Tech-Pro) programs. This ensures that learners will secure high-quality work immersion placements, developing their industry-ready skills, and enhancing their future employability.



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To maximize these opportunities and ensure timely learner placement, the following are requested:

1. Regional and Division offices are strongly encouraged to disseminate this information to the School Work Immersion Coordinators. This will ensure that schools are guided in matching and deploying their learners for the current school year.
2. TVL/Tech-Pro supervisors are requested to review the list of industries, as well as to find and endorse them to the schools that matched with their offerings.
3. Schools are directed to communicate to potential industry partners and provide details and information required for the Work Immersion.
