**TRAINING- WORKSHOP ON INTEGRATING EMERGENCY LEARNING CONTINUITY
INTO SCHOOL DROP-OUT REDUCTION PROGRAM(SDORP)**

1. The SDO Escalante City will conduct a **Training- Workshop on Integrating Emergency Learning Continuity into School Drop-out Reduction Program** on **July 30, 2026** at Gabriella Hall.
2. This activity aims to :
 - a. explain the core principles of DO 14, s. 2026 and the mechanics of the 4H Framework as they apply to localized risk management and student retention;
 - b. integrate the emergency continuity protocols of DO 14, s. 2026 into existing Project Padayon frameworks across individual elementary and secondary schools;
 - c. formulate an updated *Learning and Service Continuity Plan (LSCP)* that specifies localized responses, capability mapping, and emergency call trees targeting Learners At Risk of Dropping Out (SARDOs/PARDOs); and
 - d. establish clear mechanisms for the utilization of localized emergency learning kits, low-stakes learning adjustments, and Psychological First Aid (PFA) during transitions.



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3. The participants to this activity are the 42 school heads, CID-EPSs & 2 Staff, EPSA & ALS Teachers, 4-TWG/SGOD Personnel.
4. School Heads are required to bring **laptop** and the list of Learners At Risk of Dropping Out/LARDO & 3D's (Deprived, Depressed & Disadvantaged) on the previous school year.
5. Supplies, materials and other expenses incurred relative to the conduct of the activity are chargeable against Local Funds /School MOOE subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
6. It is understood that in the conduct of this activity, there shall be no discrimination on the account of age, school gender, civil status, disability, religion or other similar circumstances that run counter to the principle of equal opportunities.
7. Immediate and wide dissemination of this Memorandum are desired.
