**MUSIKAPULUAN SUGILANON: A NATIONAL SUMMIT AND DIALOGUE ON SUSTAINING
THE ECOLOGY OF LIVING PHILIPPINE MUSIC TRADITION**

1. In celebration of the richness and diversity of Philippine musical heritage, this office shall participate of the **MUSIKAPULUAN Sugilanon: A National Summit and Dialogue on Sustaining the Ecology of Living Philippine Music Traditions to be held on August 6-8, 2026**, at Silliman University, Dumaguete City.
2. This national gathering aims to assess the sustainability and current state of Philippine music traditions across cultural communities and regions by bringing them together cultural bearers, educators, scholars, practitioners, and policymakers from Luzon, Visayas, and Mindanao for meaningful dialogue and knowledge exchange. The summit further seeks to document and promote best practices and community initiatives that strengthen public appreciation and cultural identity through Philippine music traditions, while developing policy directions and strategic recommendations that support the preservation, continuity, and growth of Philippine music and performing art under Republic Act No. 11904, otherwise known as the Philippine Creative Industries Development Act.
3. The registration fee for the summit is Php 2,000 per participant, inclusive of lunch meals, summit materials, and admission in the gala performance. The Registration Fee may be charged from Local/MOOE Funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
4. The registration is on or before July 30, 2026. To register, visit tinyurl.com/musikapuluan26.
