**RECIPIENTS OF THE FY 2026 SPECIAL EDUCATION (SPED)
PROGRAM SUPPORT FUNDS (PSF)**

Public Elementary and Secondary School Heads
All Other Concerned

1. Pursuant to **DepEd Order No. 021, s. 2019**, entitled **Policy Guidelines on the K to 12 Basic Education Program**, it is provided that appropriate programs and services shall be extended to learners with disabilities. These include academic interventions, curriculum adaptation, learning resource support, career and guidance counseling, and transition programs, among others.
2. As per DepEd Regional Memorandum No. 754, s. 2026, which provides funding support for special needs education, and DepEd Memorandum No. OM-LS-2026 from the Office of the Undersecretary for Learning Systems: schools that offer Special Education programs, as well as those with learners officially enrolled with special needs in the LIS, shall be eligible for this funding.
3. Attached is the list of public elementary, secondary, and Senior High Schools designated as recipients of the SPED Program Support Funds, with allocated amounts indicated for utilization.
4. Eligible Expenses found in **DepEd Order No. 42 s. 2021 “Guidelines on the Utilization of Program Support Funds for Special Education Program”** (Issued: October 4, 2021) are stated below:
 - 4.1. The PSF downloaded to schools shall be used, among others, to support the educational services of LWDs in Public Elementary, Secondary schools and Senior High Schools that are implementing the SPED Program. The following shall be considered allowable expenses:
 - 4.1.1. Formal assessment or rehabilitation of LWDs by Medical or Allied Medical specialists;
 - 4.1.2. Acquisition of specialized materials, devices and equipment that are intended for Instructional Purposes of Learners with Disability/Difficulty instructional purposes provided that the amount



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do not exceed Php 15,000.00;

5. The PSF shall only be utilized to support the implementation of the program based on the eligible expenses reflected in the School Annual Implementation Plan (AIP)
6. Enclosed herewith is the list of recipient schools and the amount allocated. SARO per school is available at the Budget Section.
7. Immediate and wide dissemination of this Memorandum is hereby desired.
