CONDUCT OF NATIONAL TECHVOC DAY 2026

1. Pursuant to the provisions of Republic Act No. 10970, otherwise known as the National Technical-Vocational Day Act, all public secondary schools offering Technical-Vocational-Livelihood (TVL) programs are hereby directed to conduct the celebration of National Tech-Voc Day 2026 at the school level on August 25, 2026, from 3:00 PM to 5:00 PM.

2. This activity aims to:

- a. Promote awareness and appreciation of Technical-Vocational Livelihood (TVL) and training among learners and stakeholders;
- b. Highlight learners' skills, talents, innovations, and achievements in various TVL specializations;
- c. Strengthen support for technical-vocational education through community and industry engagement; and
- d. Encourage learners to pursue productive career pathways through technical-vocational education and skills development.

3. Schools shall observe and implement appropriate activities consistent with the objectives and suggested programs for the celebration of National Tech-Voc Day as provided under Republic Act No. 10970 and related issuances. Activities may include but are not limited to:

- a. Skills demonstrations and exhibits;
- b. Product displays and entrepreneurship showcases;
- c. Skills competitions;
- d. Career advocacy and orientation activities;
- e. Recognition of outstanding TVL learners, teachers, and partners; Community engagement and industry linkages; and other relevant activities promoting technical-vocational education and skills development.

4. All activities shall be conducted within the prescribed schedule of 3:00 PM to 5:00 PM on August 25, 2026 and shall ensure the active participation of all TVL learners, teachers, and stakeholders.

5. Expenses relative to the conduct of the activity shall be charged against school funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
