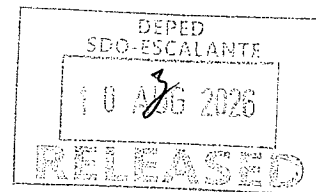

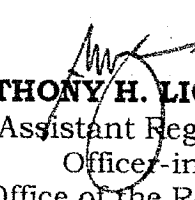

With the theme, The New Face Continues: Laboratory and Youth Shaping the Next Chapter of the Cooperative Movement, the 2026 LabYou NatCon aims to strengthen cooperative education among the youth, enhance leadership formation, promote innovation, and reinforce the role of laboratory cooperatives as training grounds for responsible and values-driven future leaders.
