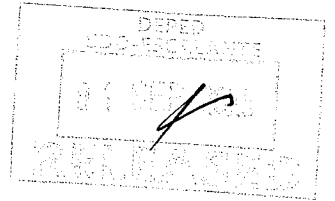

6. Immediate dissemination and compliance with this memorandum are desired.

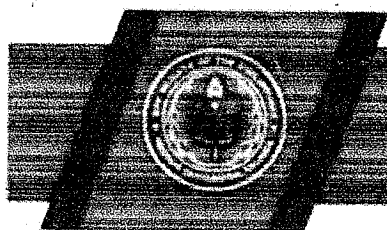

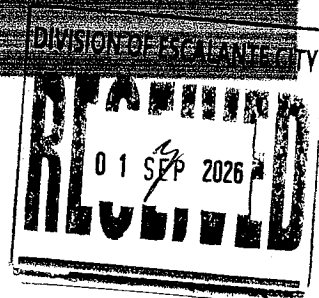

2. The Objectives of this training aims:

- ✓ Equip our Senior Scouts on how to survive in the forest or jungle using an improved shelter and utensils.
- ✓ Teaching our Scouts on how to look and identify the edible and non-edible plants and animals using their power of observations introduced by the founder of Scouting.
- ✓ Conduct tree planting activity, clean –up drive in forest, and train them on how to care trees and animals, other techniques in protecting our natural resources for future generation.

3. Registration: A registration fee of **Seven Hundred Pesos Only (Php. 700.00)** shall be charged each participant to defray and cover the transportation, certificates, survival neckerchief and other administrative expenses and meals of the members of the Survival Training Course Staff.

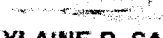

- a) Must be currently registered Senior Scouts. (13 years old but not over 17 years old)
- b) Must be a holder of Outdoorsman Scout Rank for Venturer Scout Aspirants Survival Training Course.
- c) Must be a holder of Venturer Scout Rank for Eagle Scout Aspirants Survival Training Course.
- d) Duly examined by a registered Physician certifying good health condition to attend this event.
- e) Parents Permit
