PROVISION OF TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE TO THE SCHOOLS IN ADDRESSING CONCERNS ON LITERACY AND NUMERACY PERFORMANCE

1. Pursuant to Republic Act (RA) No. 12028, or the “Academic Recovery and Accessible Learning (ARAL) Program Act of 2024,” and the Regional Memorandum No. 948, s. 2026, titled “Provision of Technical Assistance to the Schools Division Offices in Addressing Concerns on Literacy and Numeracy Performance,” the SDO (Schools Division Office) of Escalante City shall provide technical assistance to schools in addressing identified concerns in literacy and numeracy performance on September 11, 14 , & 15 , 2026 at Gabriella Hall and ENHS.
2. The activity aims to assist schools in analyzing literacy and numeracy performance, validating the root causes of identified learning gaps, and mapping targeted technical assistance opportunities using the 4D’s Technical Assistance Framework (Data, Discussion, Direction, and Desired Outputs/Outcomes), aligned with the principles of the Philippine Qualifications Framework (PQF).
3. The overall activity cycle of the activity includes Pre-Engagement (Data Collection & Analysis), On-site Facilitation and Post Engagement (Continuous Monitoring).
4. For the pre-engagement, the identified school heads are advised to join the FGD (Focus Group Discussion) on September 11, 2026, at 9:00 a.m. at Gabriela Hall and bring school data on Literacy and Numeracy (BoSY), as well as the least mastered competencies per grade level. See attached list of participants in this Memorandum.
5. It is understood that in the conduct of this activity, there shall be no discrimination on the account of age, school gender, civil status, disability, religion or other similar circumstances that run counter to the principle of equal opportunities.
6. The participants’ food, travelling and other incidental expenses shall be changeable against local/ARAL funds subject to usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
7. Immediate and wide dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
